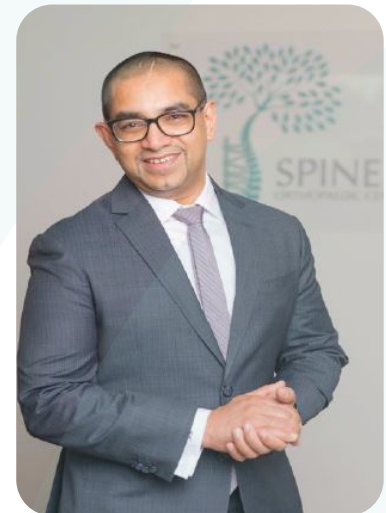
Mr Rez Rahim Spinal & Orthopaedic Surgeon
